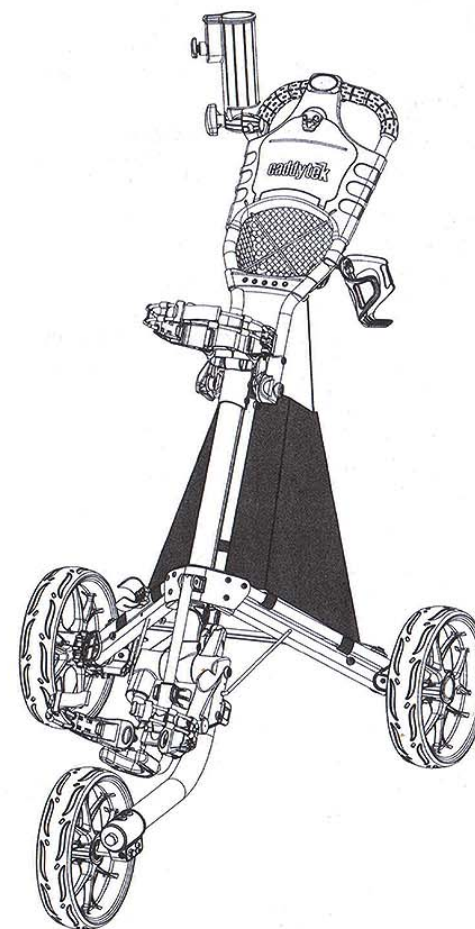

- Keep hands and fingers away from moving parts or sliding sections of the cart!

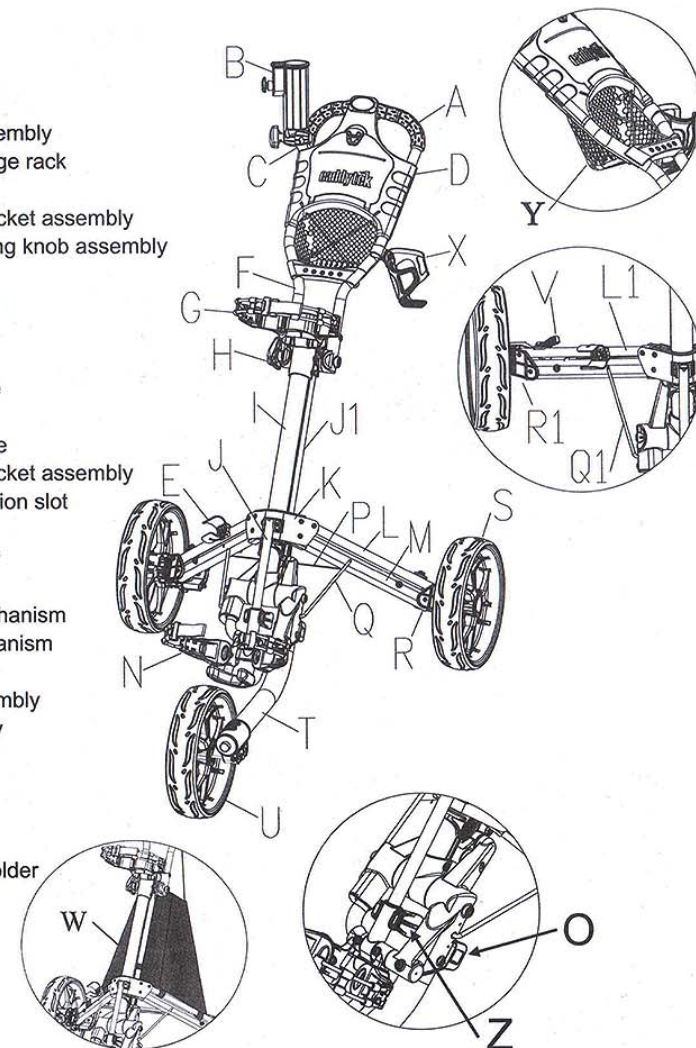

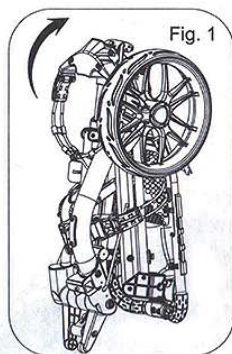

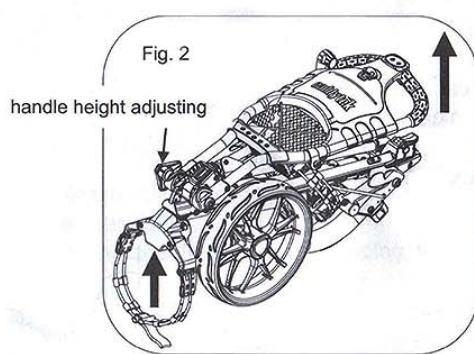
- A: PVC handle grip

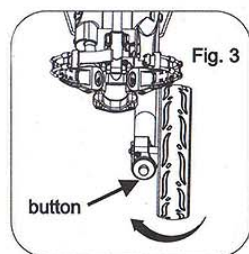
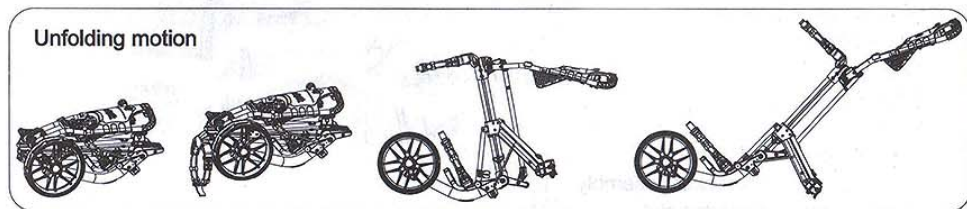
Assembly the car



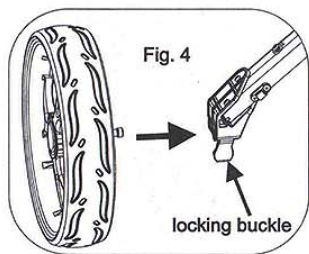
Lift the upper bag holder bracket



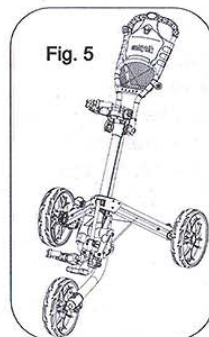
Make sure the handle height adjusting knob is fully tighten . Pull the handle and upper bag bracket as shown in Fig. 2 to extend the cart. (Shake the cart slightly to release the main frame from the holding slot if necessary.)



As shown in Fig 3, press the button and rotate the front wheel 180 degree clockwise so the front wheel is at center of the cart.

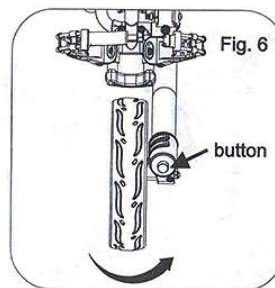


Release the wheel locking buckle, insert the wheel axel into the wheel holder completely and then tighten the locking buckle.

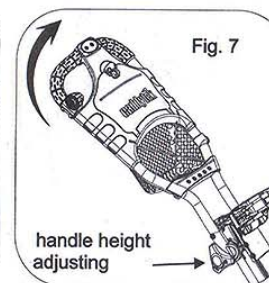


The cart is fully extended as shown in Fig. 5

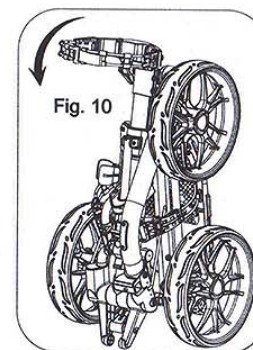
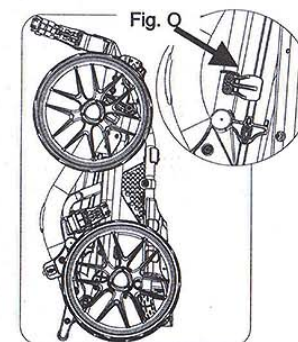
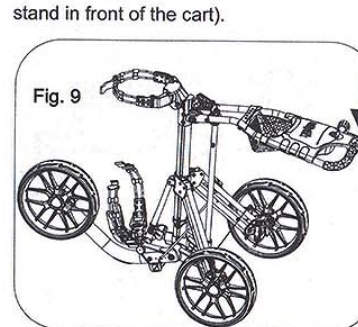
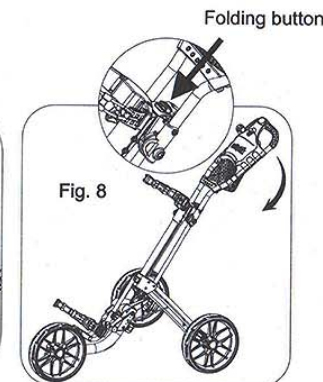
Folding the cart



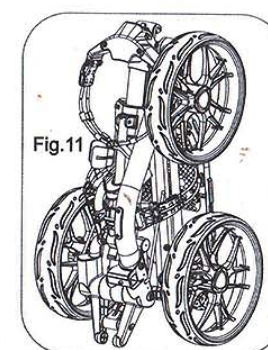
Press the button and rotate the front wheel 180 degree counterclockwise so the front wheel is on the right of the front wheel fork (when you stand in front of the cart).



Make sure the handle height adjusting knob is fully tighten .Slightly lift up the handle as Fig. 7 then press the folding button and push the handle downward as shown in Fig. 8 , Fig. 9 to fold the cart till the main frame clicks into the holding slot as in Fig. O.

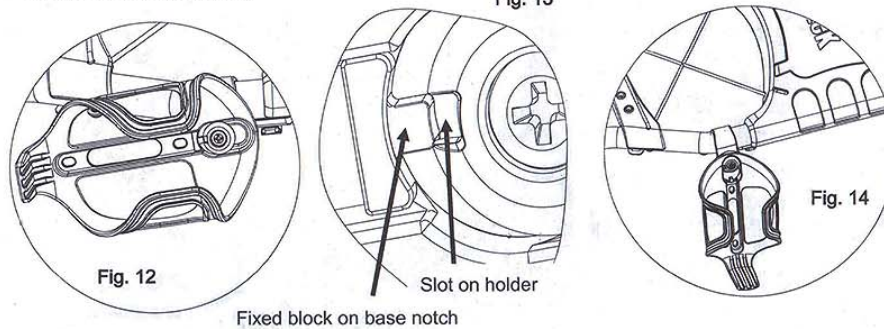


Fold down the upper bag holder bracket



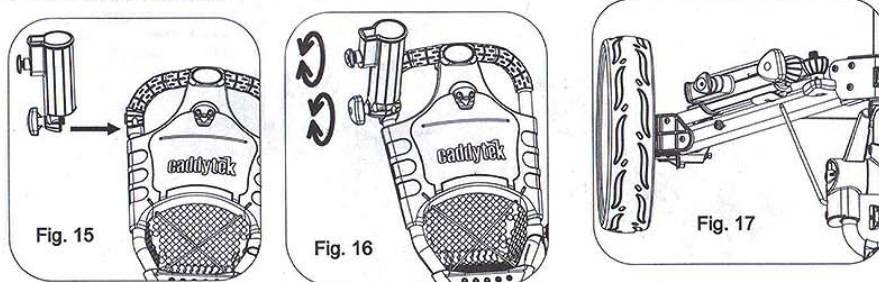
The cart is fully folded.

Install the drink holder



When installing the drink holder, align the smallest part of the slot on the holder with the fixed blocks. Then pull horizontally to fit the holder on the base.

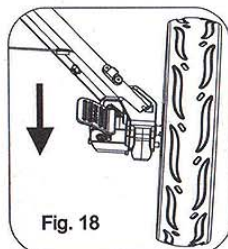
Umbrella Holder



To put in use:
Simply attach the umbrella holder onto the cart as in fig. 15/16

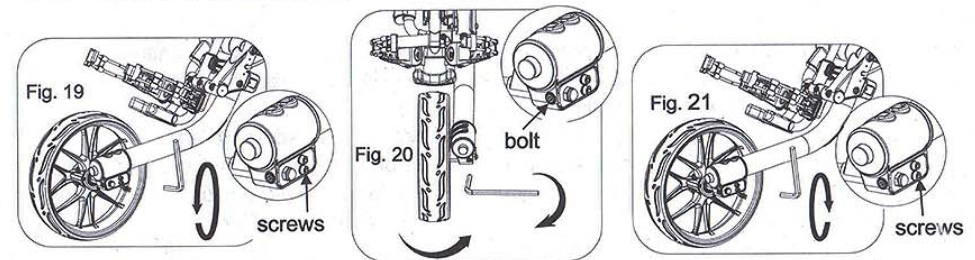
To store:
Attach the umbrella holder to the storage rack on the right leg frame as in Fig. 17.

Use the brake



Press the brake pedal to brake and push again to release as Fig. 18

Front Wheel Alignment



If the cart veers to the right:

Step 1: Face the front wheel of the cart and use the provided Allen wrench to loose the two side screws as in fig. 19.

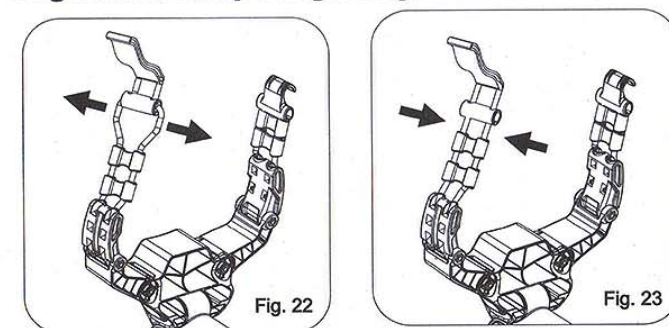
Step 2: Then use the Allen wrench to adjust the front bolt clockwise until the front wheel is centered as in Fig. 20. Then tighten the two side screws as in fig. 21.

If the cart veers to the left:

Step1: The same as above.

Step 2: Adjust the front bolt counterclockwise until the front wheel is centered as in fig.20. Then tighten the two side screws as in fig. 21.

Bag Holder Strap Length Adjustment



Refer to the Fig. 22 & Fig. 23:

1. Pull the elastic strap out of the strap buckle as in fig. 22
2. Adjust the strap to the desired length.
3. Push the elastic strap back to the strap buckle as in fig. 23
